Current Research Projects

- Dynamic Emotion in the Context of Parenting: ecological momentary assessment (text-message) methods to understand the directionality of parent-child emotion and emotion regulation dynamics
- Latina Moms Study: unique risk and protective factors in the associations between parent stress and child executive function in Latina-identifying mothers across the United States
- SEAL/OTTER (NIH-Funded, PI: Fisher): identification of behavioral, cognitive, and neural mechanisms underlying the effects of a strengths-based video-coaching intervention for low-income parents and people parenting in the context of opioid addiction

Data Available from Completed Research Projects

- Parent-Child Self-Regulation Study: survey, behavioral, assessment, interaction, and MRI data on mother-child dyads regarding emotion, parenting, self-regulation, and eating behaviors
- Behavior and Environment Survey: self-report data from Oregon parents of elementary school-aged children on their family health behaviors at home and school
